
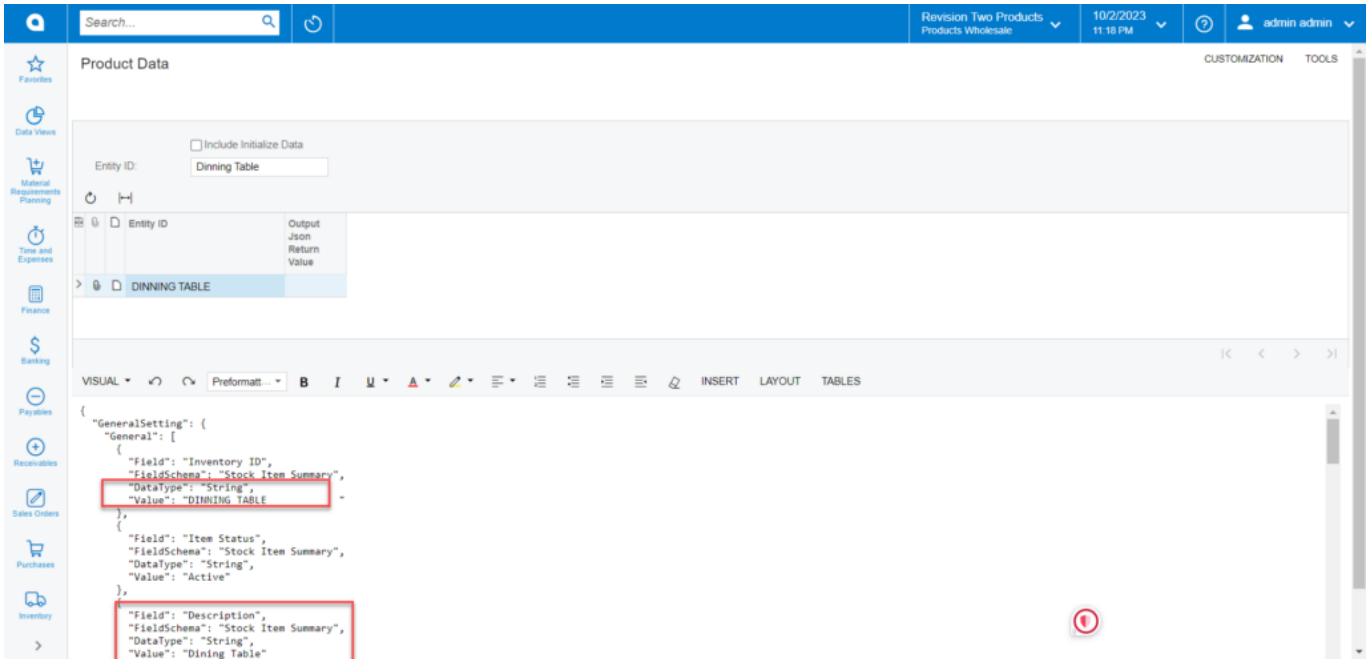


Managing Product Data
