Field	Field Type	Description	
<b>Acumatica Dashboard</b>			
Enable	Drop-down	<p>If you want to send any updates to Acumatica from Magento, you must enable the option.</p> <p>Options available</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Yes [Recommended]</li> <li>• No [If selected, the data processed in Magento will not be reflected on Acumatica irrespective of the result pass/ failed].</li> </ul>	
<b>Attribute Sync</b>			
Product	Drop-down	<p>Option available.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Enable:</b> This should be enabled. Any kind of product attribute should be accepted on the Magento side.</li> <li>• <b>Disable:</b> This option will prevent Magento from accepting the attribute from Acumatica.</li> </ul>	
Customer	Drop-down	<p>Option available.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Enable:</b> This should be enabled. Any kind of customer attribute should be accepted on the Magento side.</li> <li>• <b>Disable:</b> This option will prevent Magento from accepting the attribute from Acumatica.</li> </ul>	
<b>Category Sync</b>			
Acumatica Default Company	Text box	You need to enter the default company name if you wish. You can leave this field blank also.	
Category Sync	Drop-down	<p>Magento will only process the Item Sales Category from Acumatica if it's enabled. You will have two options.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Enable</li> <li>• Disable</li> </ul>	
Sync direction	Drop-down	Sync Director must be set from Acumatica to Magento. The application will not provide any choice for this.	

 Acumatica to Magento Exclude Required Attributes	List	<p>To make the mapping perfect, it's mandatory to have the same field on the Magento and Acumatica side. However, there are a couple of fields which are not present in the Acumatica.</p> <p>In those cases, you need to exclude a couple of attributes. Otherwise, Magento will not allow you to save the data. The following should be available on the list.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Available Product Listing Sort By</li> <li>• Default Product Listing Sort By</li> <li>• Include in the Navigation Menu</li> <li>• Is active.</li> <li>• Name</li> </ul>
Republish Message to Queue if Deadlock Error	Drop-down	<p>Due to some technical issues on the backend (SQL Service stopped) sometimes the data doesn't get processed and throws a failed status.</p> <p>In those scenarios, this option will again process the data if that has failed due to the deadlock error. The Deadlock option has been introduced in most of the syncs.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Enable (Recommended):</b> If enabled, the application will pull up the failed data from the database and process it again. Magento will republish the data automatically.</li> <li>• <b>Disable:</b> Magento will not be able to republish the data automatically.</li> </ul>
<b>Product Stock Item Sync</b>		
Product Stock Item Sync	Drop-down	<p><b>Enable:</b> It should always be enabled to sync up the products from Acumatica to Magento.</p> <p><b>Disable:</b> The product created by Acumatica will not be synced into Magento. In the connector's logs, you will be able to see the errors.</p>
Sync Direction	Drop-down	The sync direction must be always Acumatica to Magento for the Product Stock Item.
