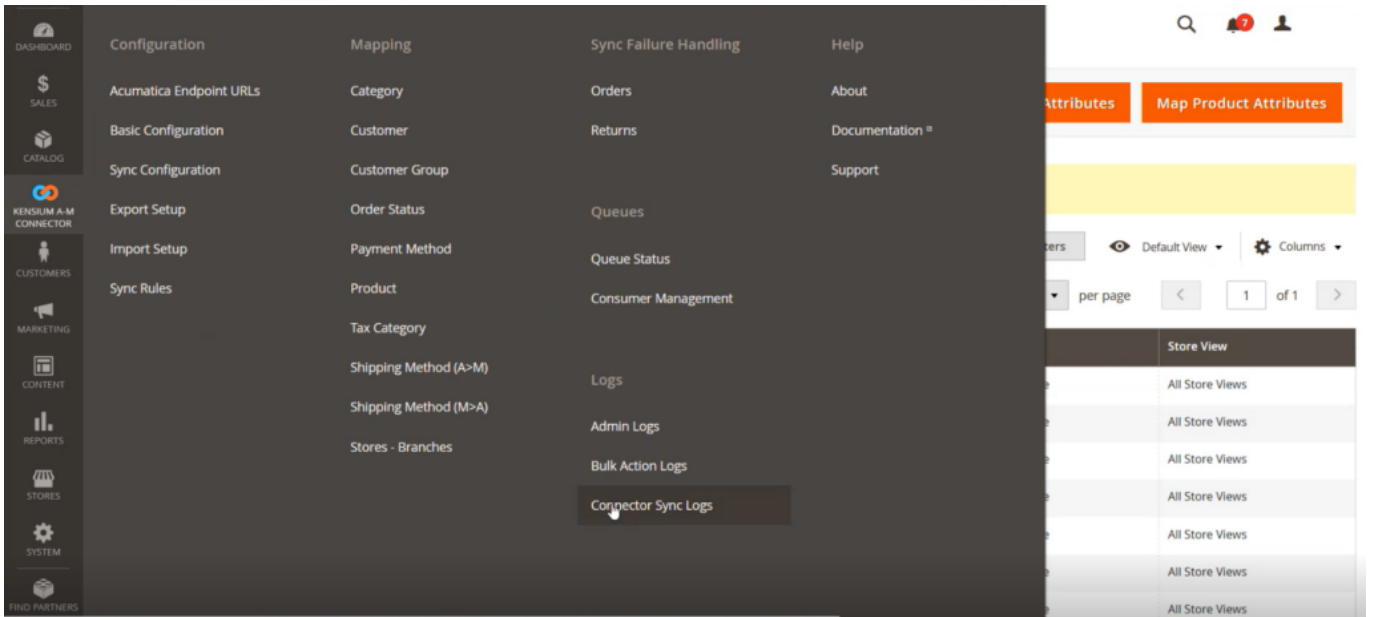


Template Items in Magento








