The first step in configuring the KCF is to set up the parameters of the connector. Navigate to the workspace and click **a**

 - The Connector Plugin may be a separate package to implement during the installation of the KCF Package.
- Next, navigate to the 🗪
- Select the Customer Classes to Sync.
- Toggle **N** Include Locations in Data Retrieval based on business need.
- When toggled on, Customer Locations will be included when the customer sync is executed.
- Toggle ON/OFF Include Contacts in Data Retrieval based on business need.
- When toggled on, Customer Contacts will be included when the customer sync is executed. Next, navigate to the
- Select the Monitored.
- Select the Sync Qty to be used for sync. Next, navigate to the

- Select the **b** to Sync.
- Toggle Sync Orders only for A to U enabled customers feature based on business need.
- When toggled on, this feature will only sync orders from customers that have been synced from Acumatica to the designated commerce platform.
- Toggle Sync Order if at least one shipment is confirmed based on business need.
- When toggled on, this feature will allow orders with multiple shipments to sync if one of these shipments is confirmed.
- Toggle orders with unpaid Balance for Sync Changes to Zero.
- Next, navigate to the Shipment Sync Trigger section.
- Select the Shipment trigger based on business process.
- Shipments can sync upon Shipment Confirmation or upon Release of the associated invoice.
- Next, navigate to the Plugin Parameters tab. These parameters are the API tokens and login information for the selected commerce integration.



- Next, navigate to the
- Toggle
 Log Info Level based on business need.
- When toggled on, all Info level actions will be logged by the connector in Acumatica. This includes all successful transmissions of data between Acumatica and the commerce platform.
- Toggle Log Error Level based on business need.
- When toggled on, all Error level actions will be logged by the connector in Acumatica. This
 includes all unsuccessful transmissions of data between Acumatica and the commerce platform.
 Next, navigate to the
- Toggle all syncs that will be used for the business need.
- The connector will execute syncs if the sync feature is enabled in this section.
- Next, navigate to the Endpoint URL tab. These fields will automatically populate with the Endpoint URLs being used based on the Plugin selected at the beginning of configuration and the base URL entered.
- The Connector is now ready to have the connection tested, and the schema configured.
