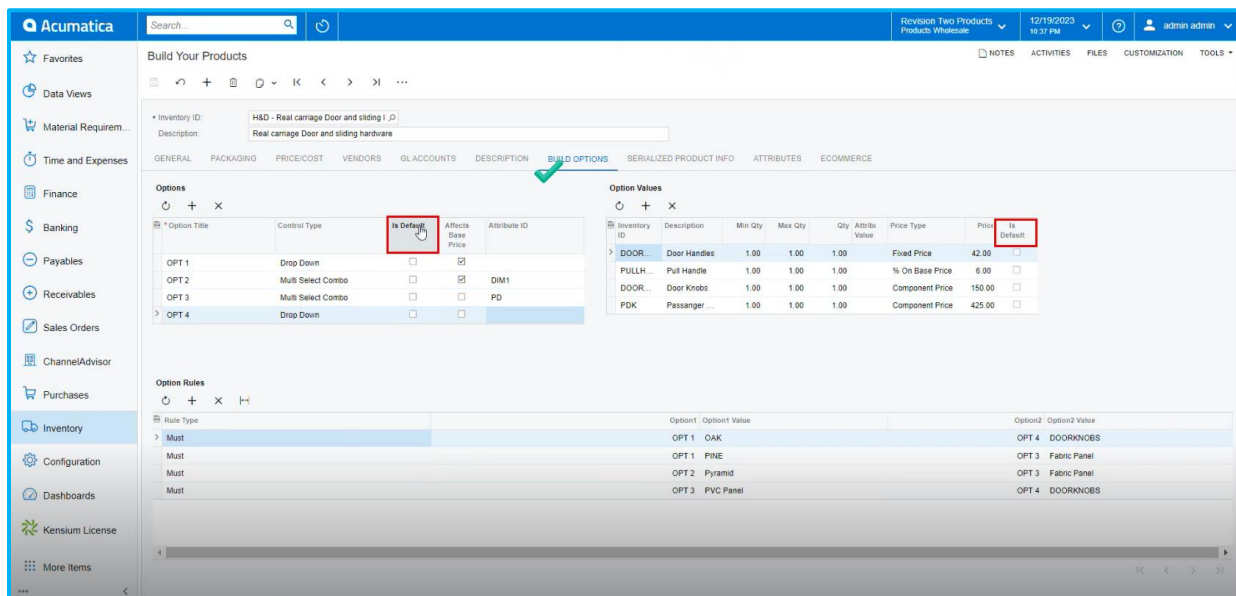

New Features and Enhancements

Is Mandatory changed to Is Default column in BYP Screen

In the Build Options of BYP, the **[Is Default]** column under [Options] and [Option Values] in the BYP Screen's Build Option has been replaced by **[Is Mandatory]**.

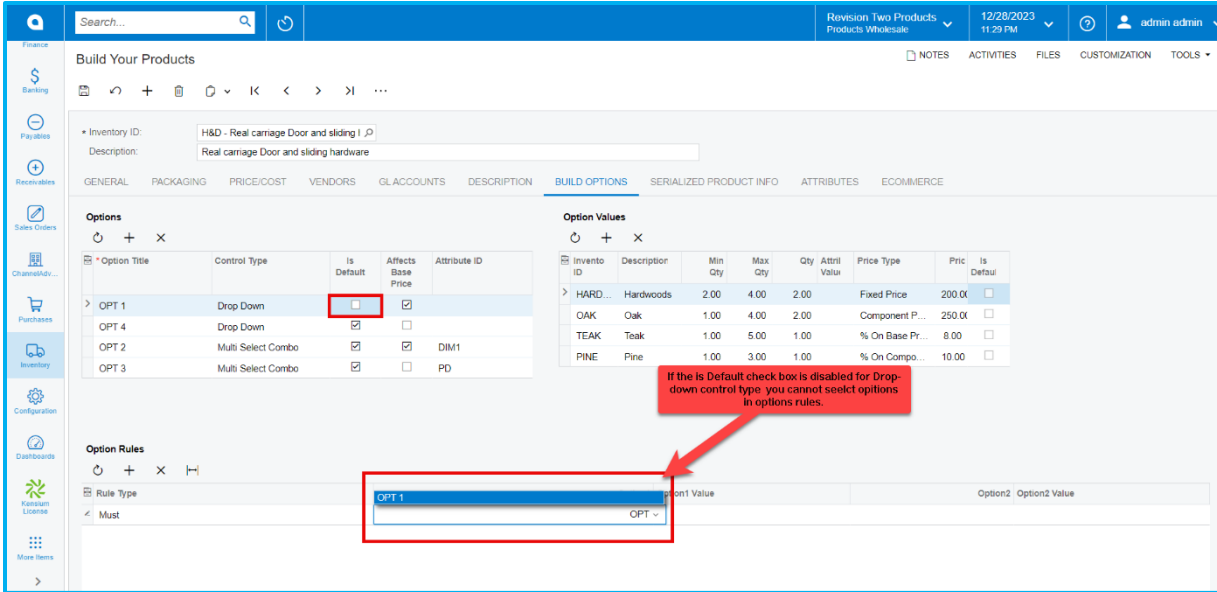


Figure: Enabled drop-down

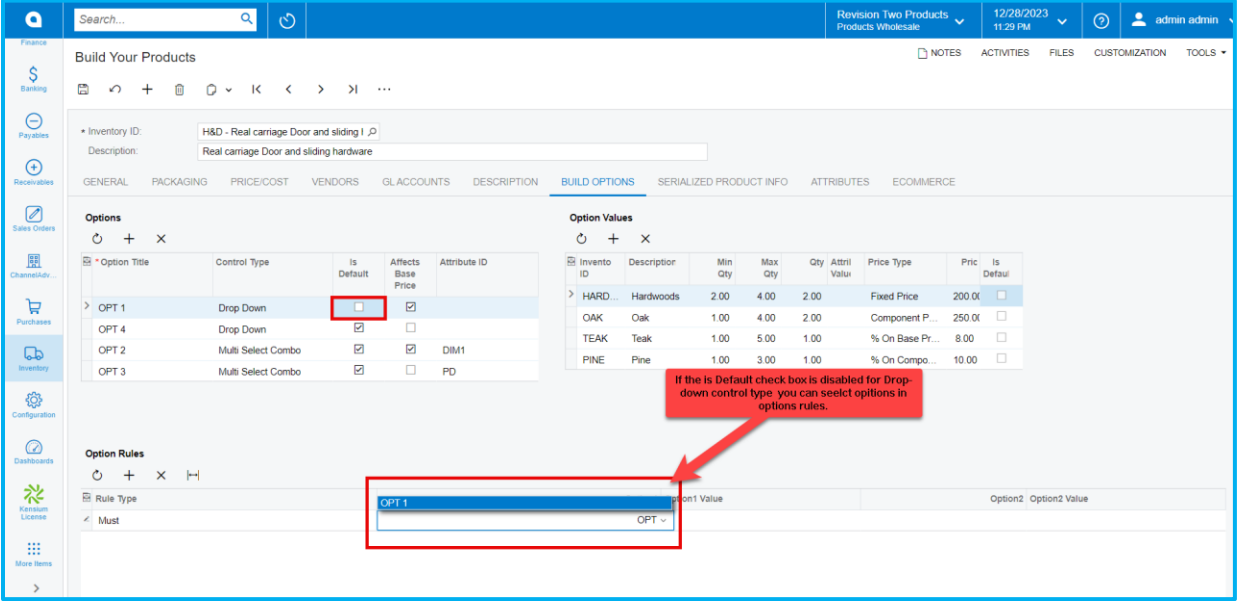


Figure: disabled drop-down

- For [Drop-Down] control type, you can select only one [Is Default] in [Options Values].

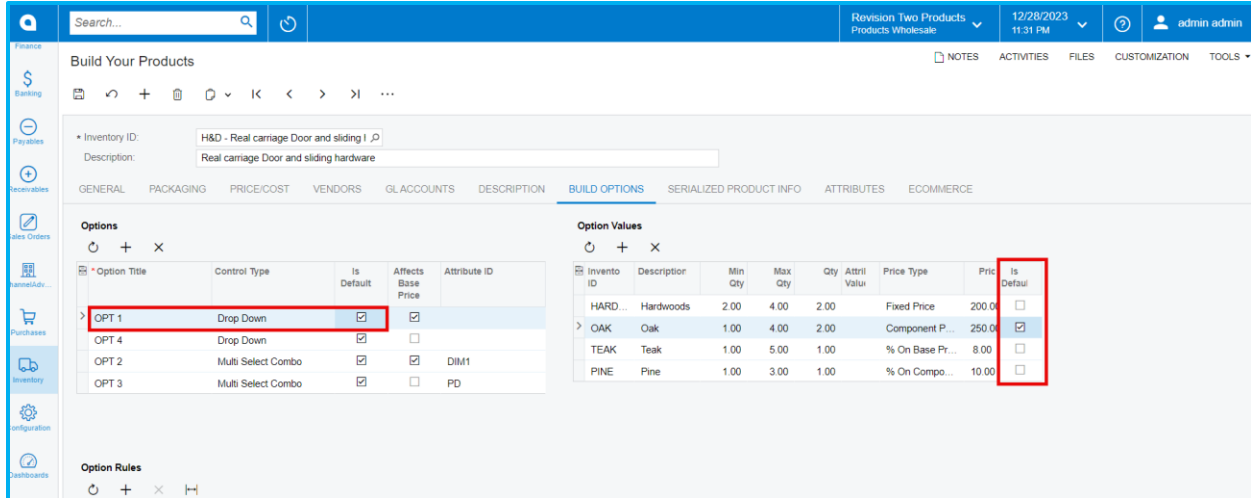


Figure: Drop-Down

Item Availability in Config BYP

To view the item availability in the **[Config BYP]** pop-up a new option was incorporated. Navigate to the Sales Orders screen and create a BYP item under the **[Inventory]**. On saving the screen the **[Config BYP]** button will be enabled.

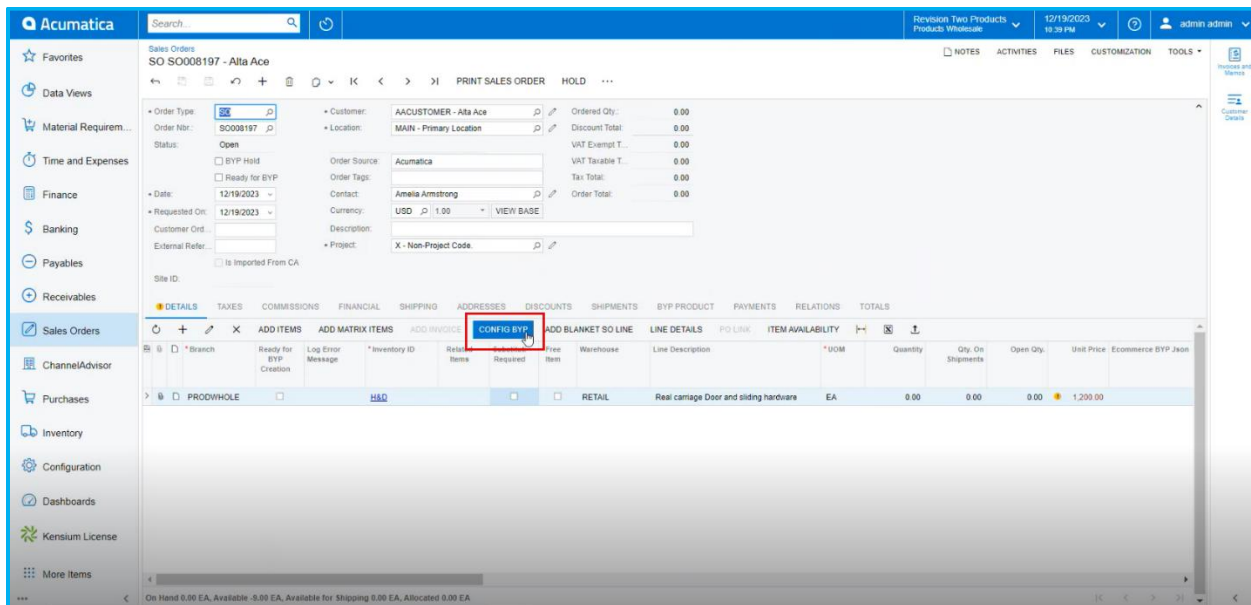


Figure: Config BYP is enabled

Upon clicking on the **[Config BYP]** a pop-up will appear on the screen. Upon selecting the BYP Products, select the products from the dropdown. If you select any product available for BYP Products, the application will show the Product availability as **On Hand, Available and Available for shipping**.

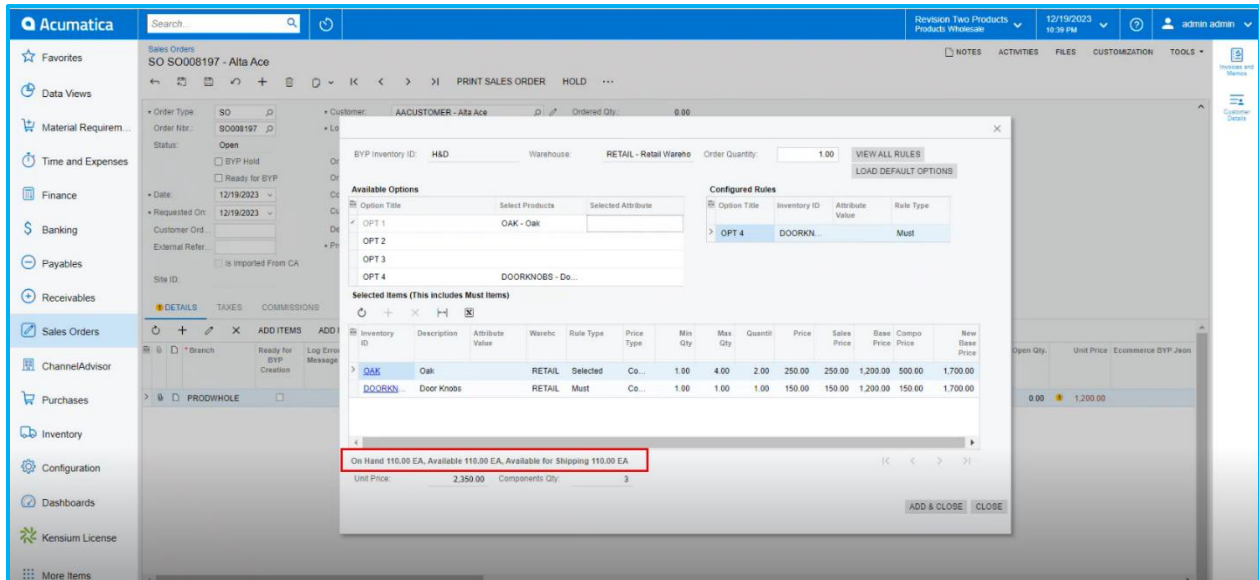


Figure: On Hand, Available and Available for shipping

Minimum and Maximum Qty added in BYP Screen

The **[Minimum]** and **[Maximum]** Qty. column in the BYP Screen was incorporated under the **[Option Values]**. This is applicable for Inventory Items; however, this feature is not applicable for the attributes. The values in these two new columns are not editable.

For inventory items, you can edit the min. and max. qty.

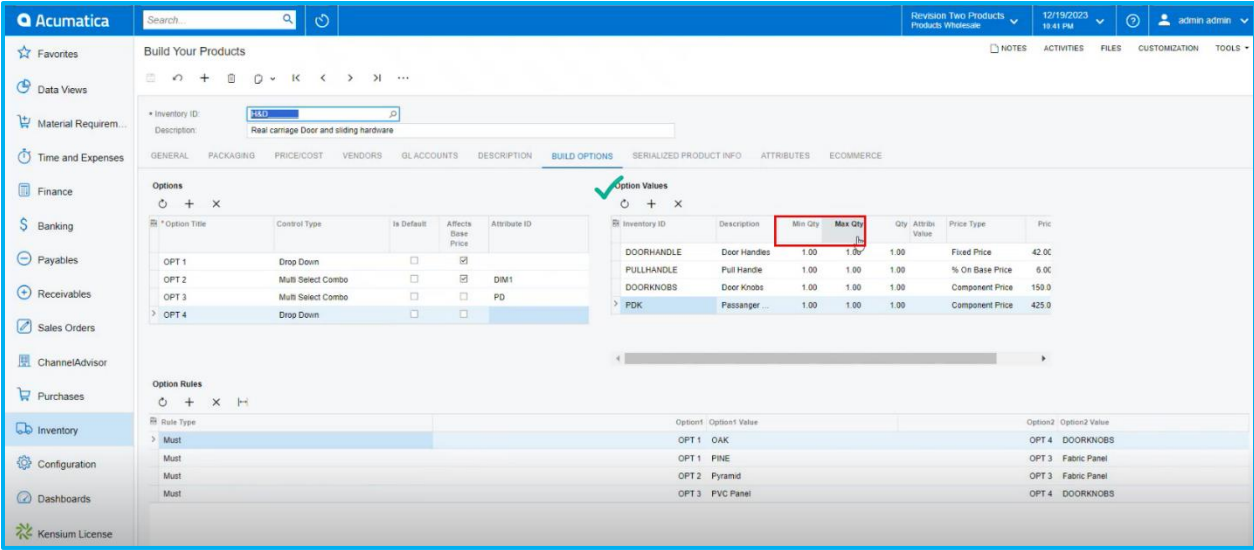


Figure: Minimum and Maximum Column under the [Option Values]

The Qty. that you select should be between the minimum and the maximum qty.

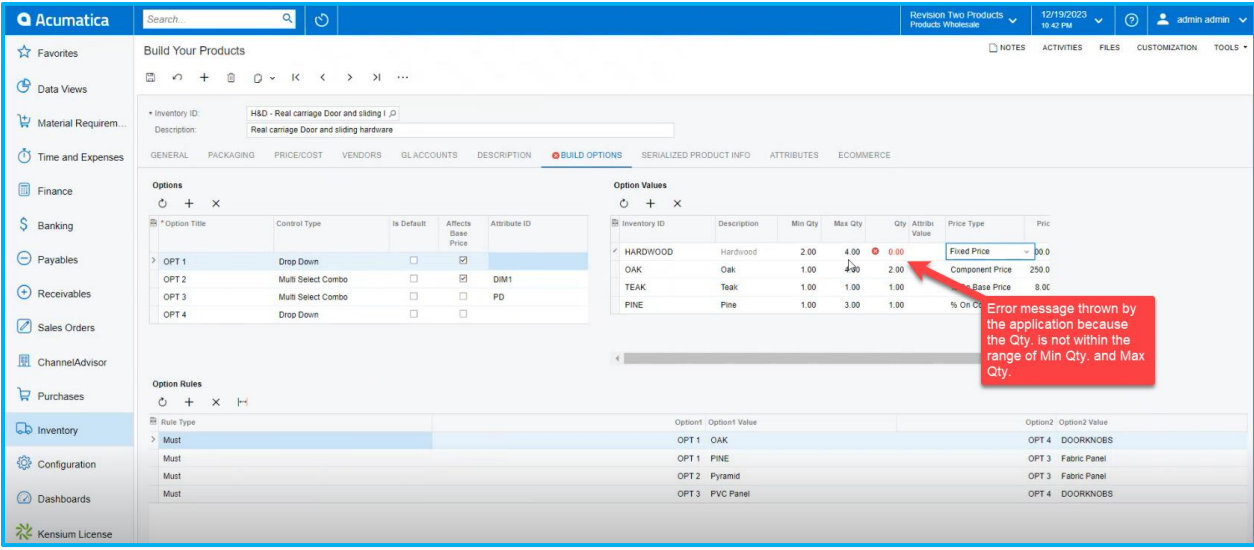
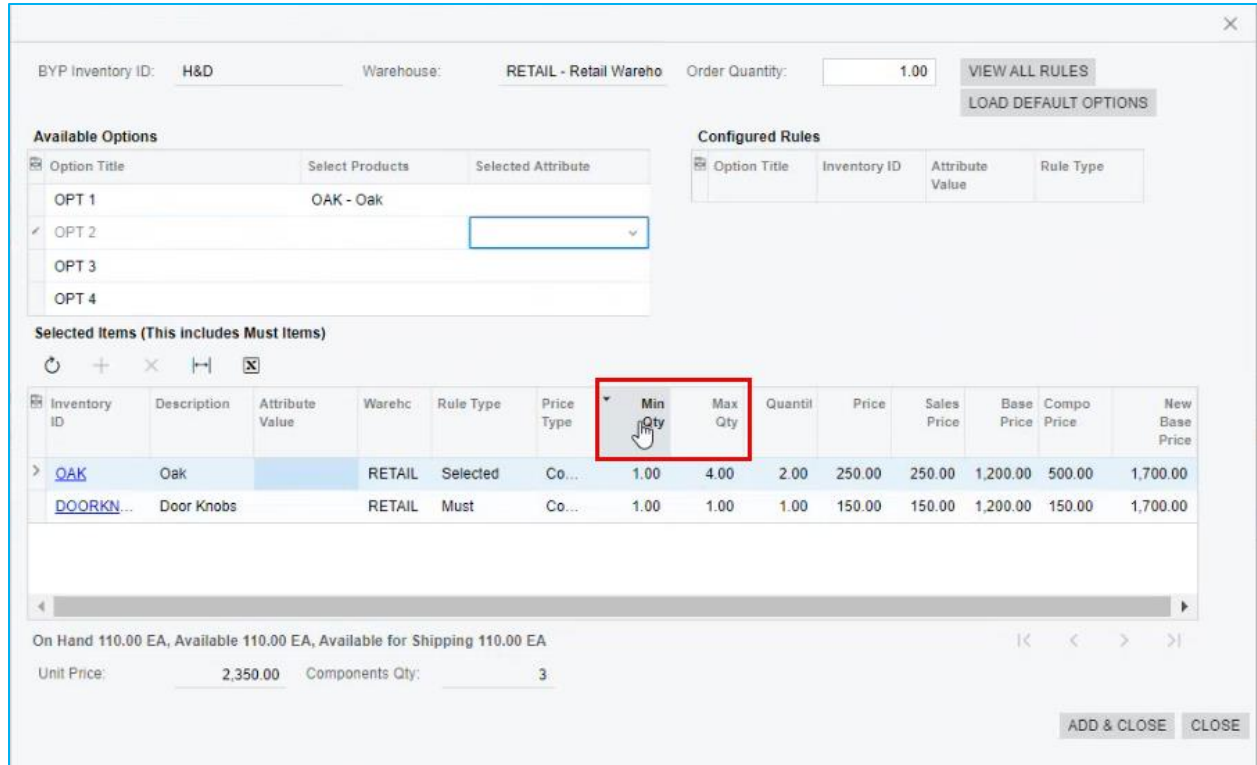


Figure: Error message appears if the Qty value is not in between the min and max.

Item Sales Price introduced in BYP Inventory

In the BYP Inventory Screen **[Sales Price]** column has been incorporated beside the price column under **[Selected Items]**.

This is applicable only for Inventory ID' however, this feature is not applicable for the attributes.

- You must select the inventory ID, then proceed to the **[Sales Prices]** screen under **[Profiles]**.

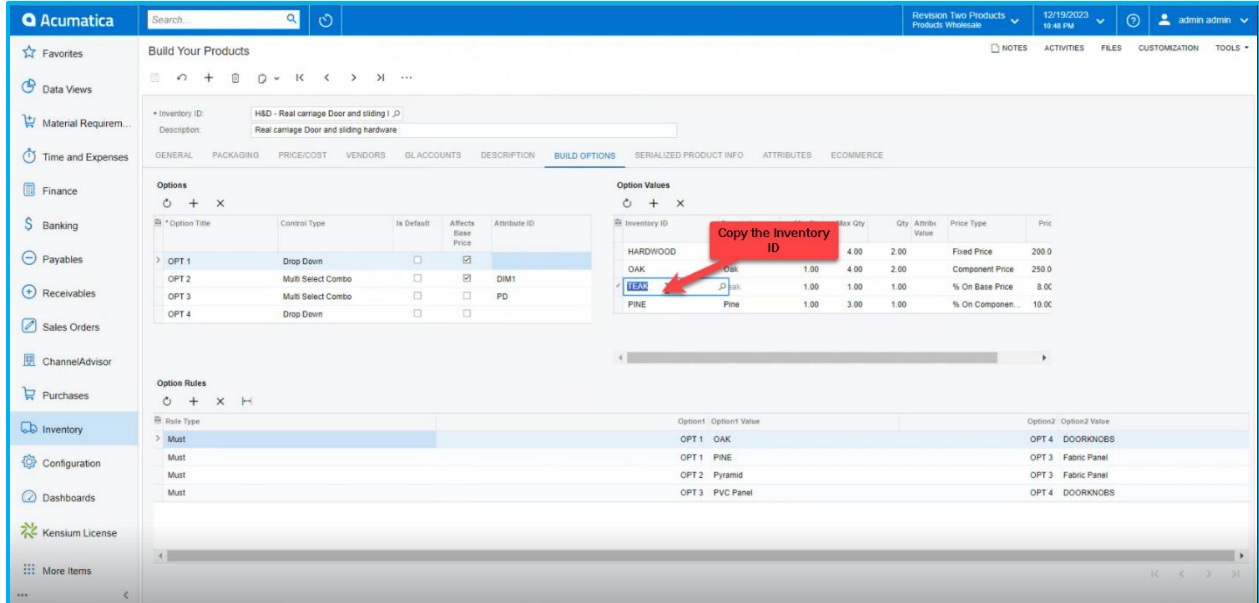


Figure: Build your Products

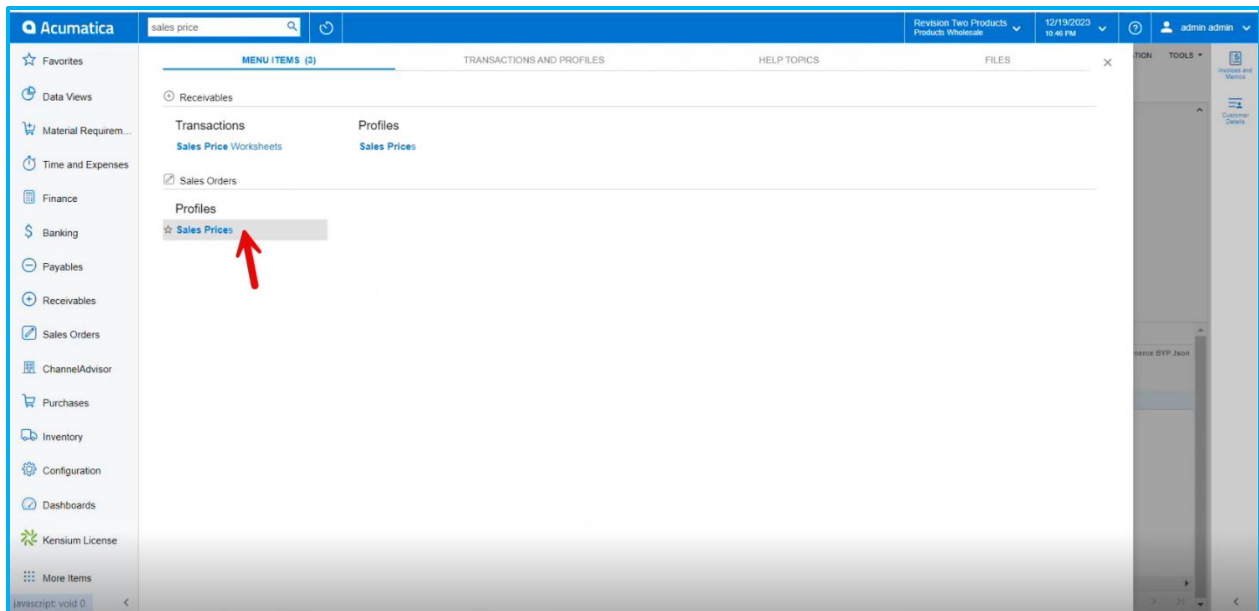


Figure: Sales Prices

- Search for the Inventory ID, If the record is not displayed, then add **Sales Prices** to the inventory.
- Select **[Price Type]** from the Drop- down Menu.
 - **Base:** This will be applicable for all the customers
 - **Customer:** Only for the selected customers

- **Customer Price Class**
- Provide **[Break Qty]** and add the **[Price]**.
- You need to select **[Effective Date]** and **[Expiration Date]** for the item.
- Click on **[Save]**.

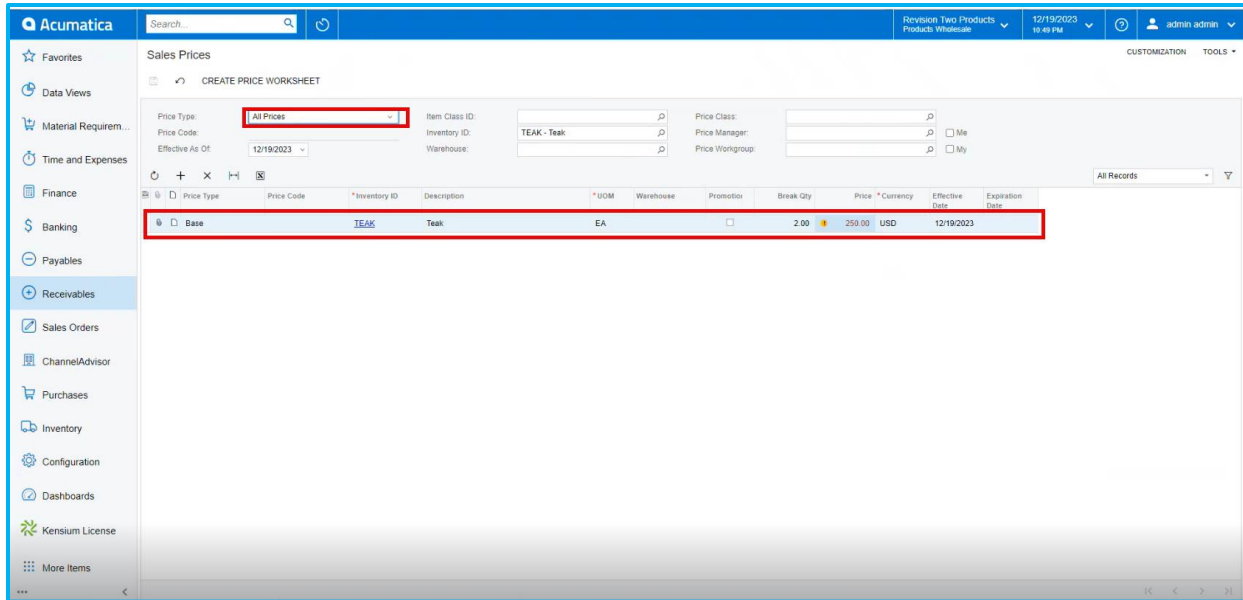


Figure: Sales Prices

- Go back to the sales orders screen and add the quantity in **[Quantity]** column under selected Items. The price will be displayed in accordance with the sales prices if the amount entered satisfies the break quantity; otherwise, the price will be the same as the stock item price.

Note: According to condition (Price type, Break qty, Price, Effective Date, and Expiration Date) that you specified in the sales prices will be updated in the sales orders screen.

- If you set Price Type as **[Customer]**, only the customers that you selected will be eligible to the Sales Prices condition.

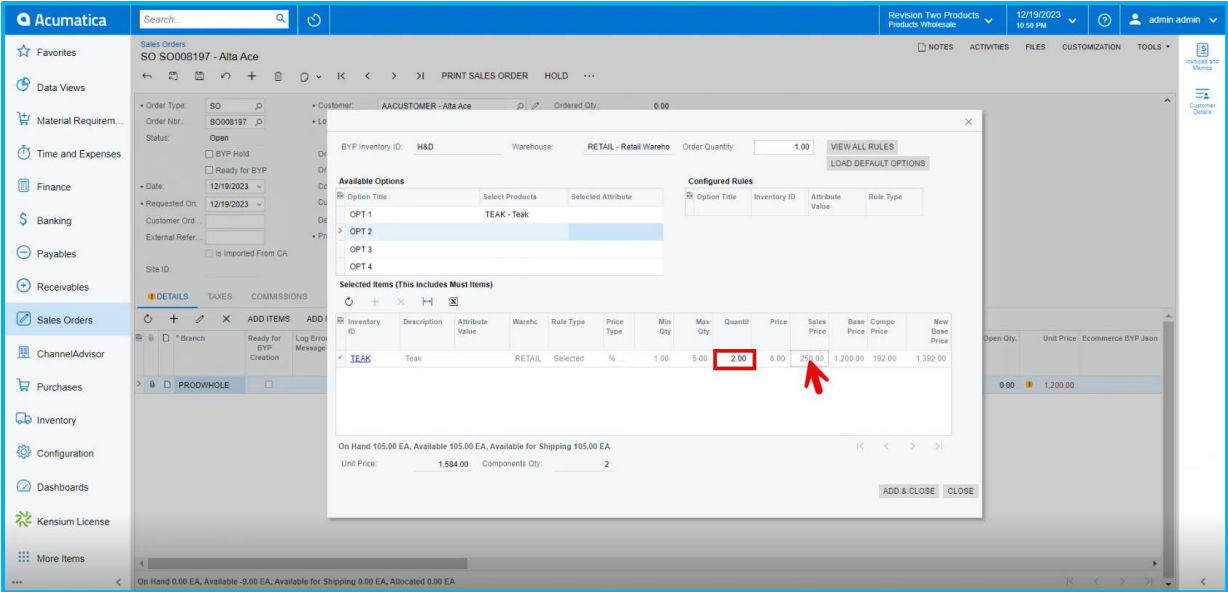


Figure: Sales Price column in BYP Inventory

In the BYP Inventory Screen the **[Sort Order]** column under **[Options]** has been eliminated.

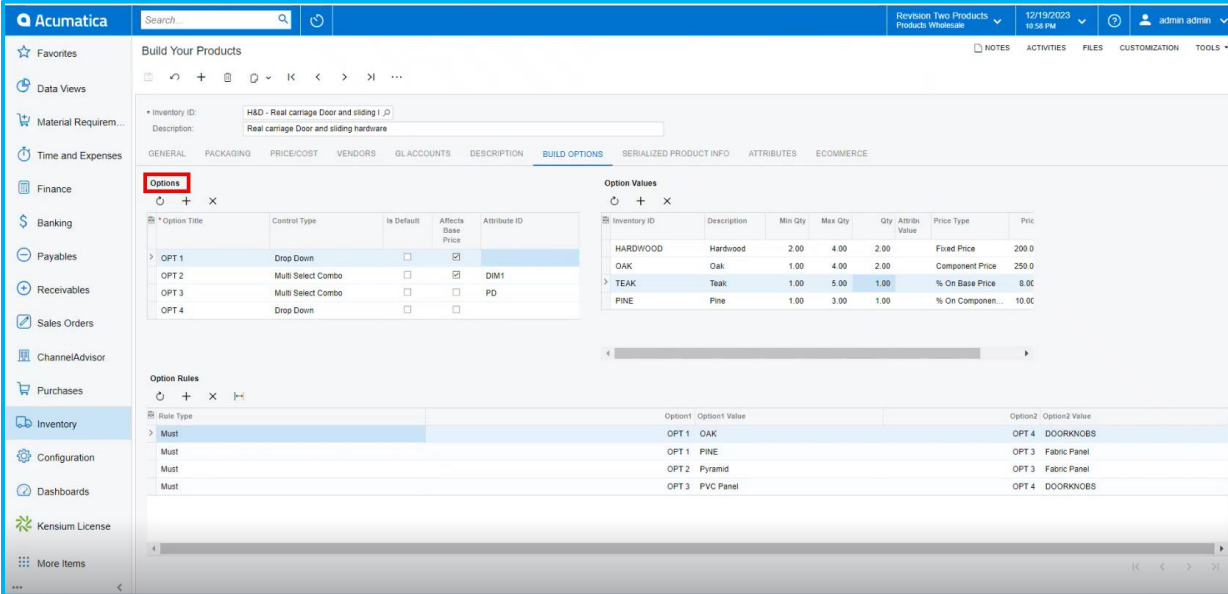
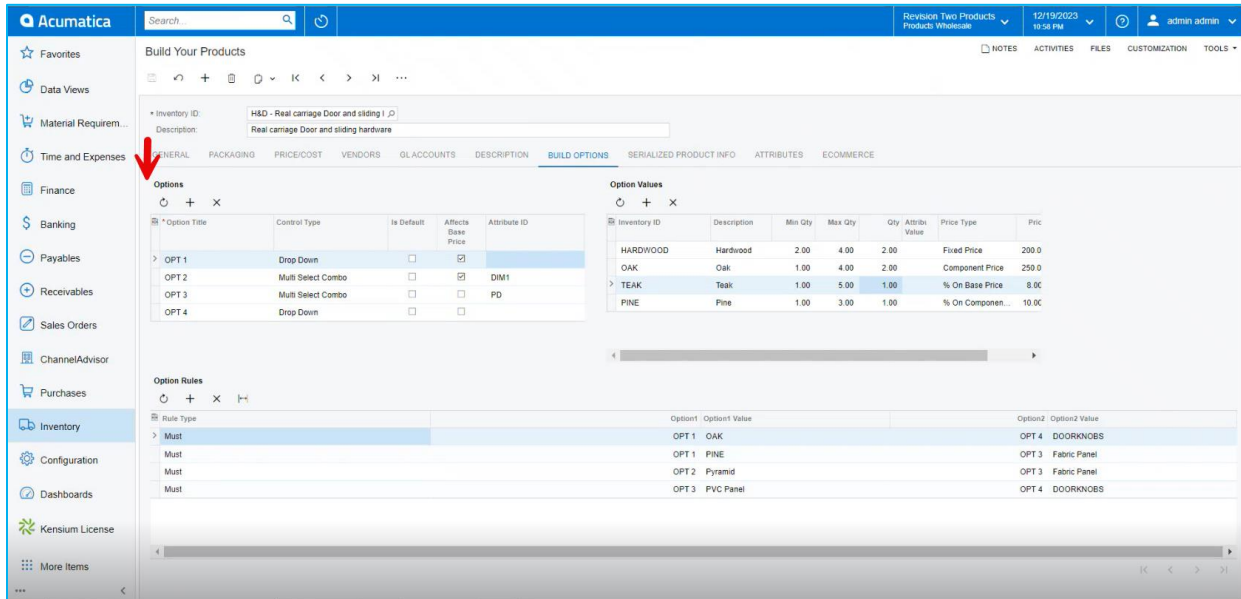


Figure: Sort Order column removed in BYP Inventory

Search Item by Description

In the BYP Inventory Screen, the **[Sales Price]** Column was incorporated beside the **[Price Column]**.

Previously, when you browsed for an Inventory ID by using the built in search feature an empty record would appear on the screen under **[Inventory ID]** in **[Options Values]**.

Now, when you search for the inventory ID by using built in search feature the record will appear on the screen under **[Inventory ID]** in **[Options Values]**.

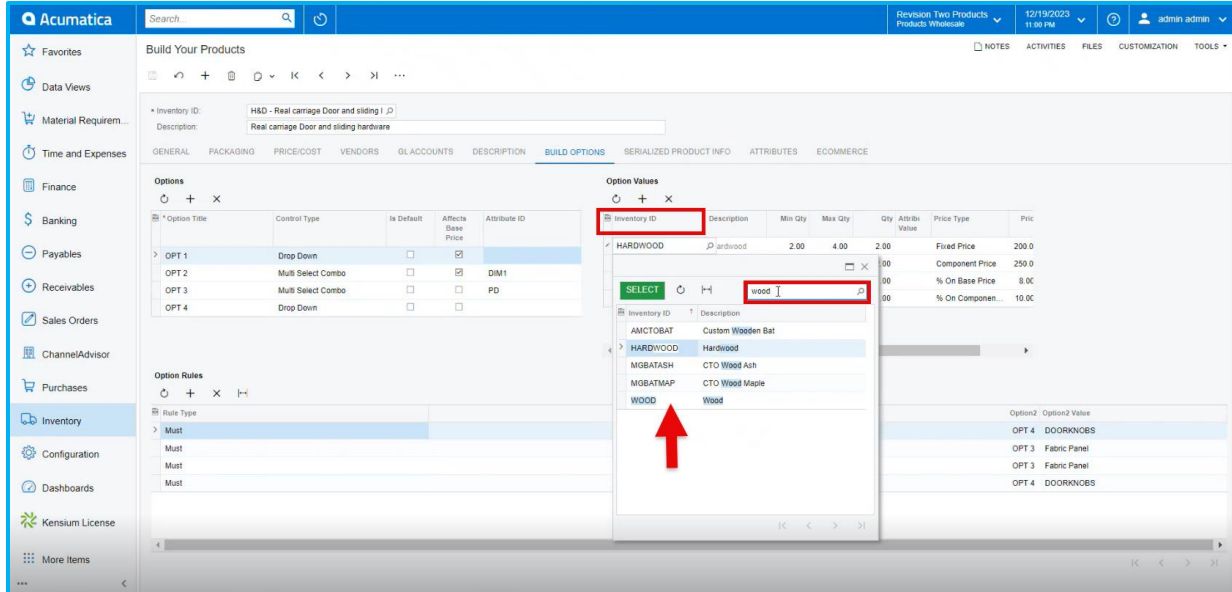


Figure: Removed Notes & Files Options in BYP Inventory

Option to Drag and Drop Records

In the **[Options]** section an option to drag the **[Option Title]** was incorporated into the Build Your Products.

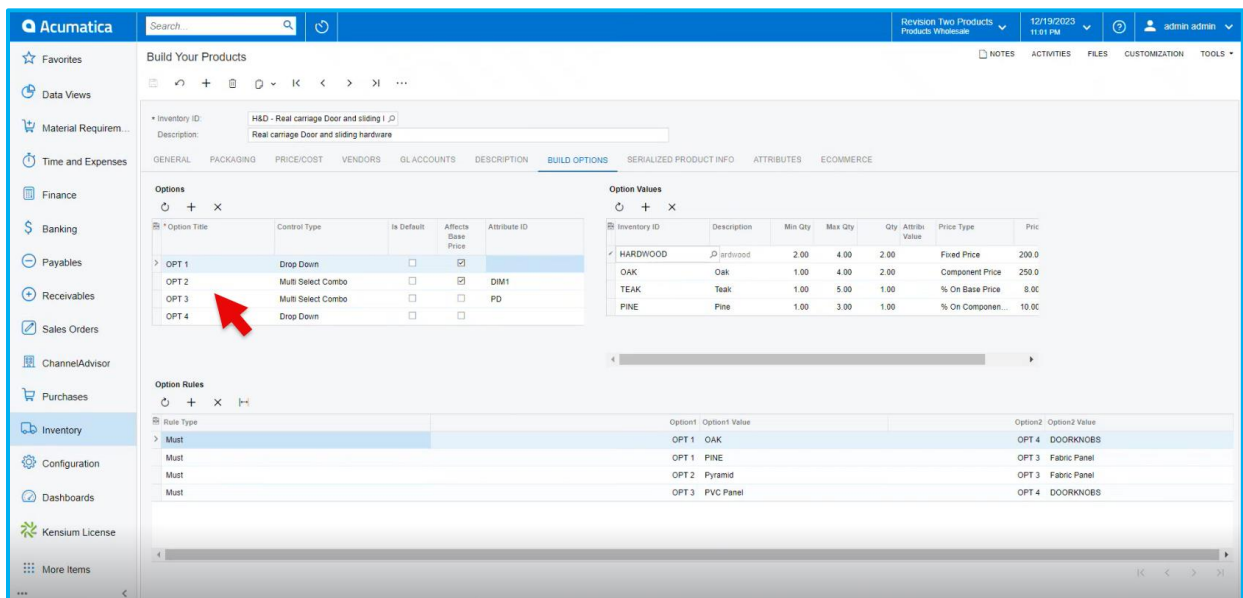


Figure: Build Your Products (Options)

- You can adjust the **[Options Title]** sequence up and down wards.

- When you adjust the **[Options Title]**, the **[Options Values]** that correspond to the **[Option titles]** also adjust according with the sequence.

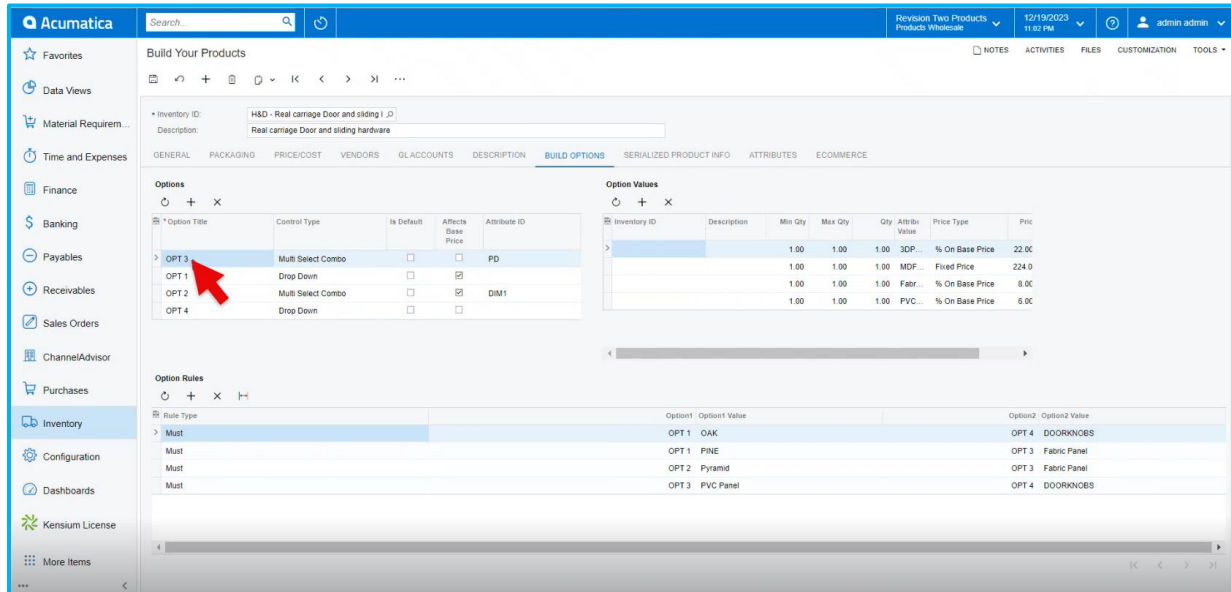


Figure: Build Your Products (Options)

- The same sequence will display in **[Configure BYP]** under **[Sales Orders]**.

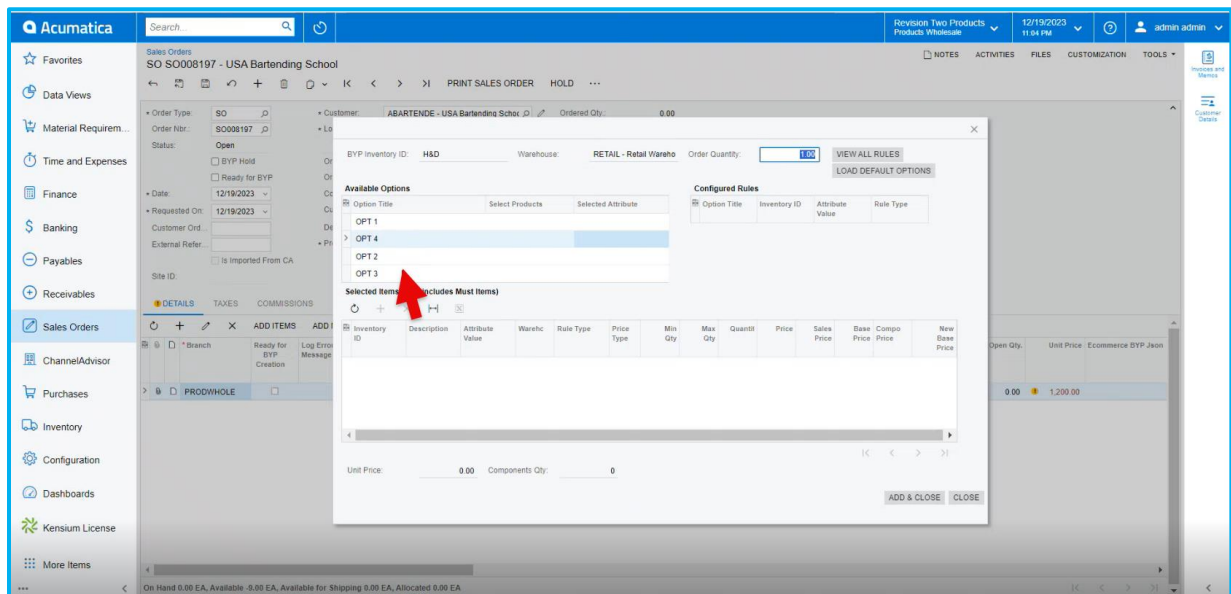


Figure: Sales Orders

Option to Copy and Paste BYP Items

In the **[BYP]** screen, **[Copy and Paste]** options were incorporated.

- Now, it is possible to copy and paste the **[Options]** together with their **[Options Values]** to the next item.
- Firstly, copy the **[Inventory ID]** in the BYP screen.

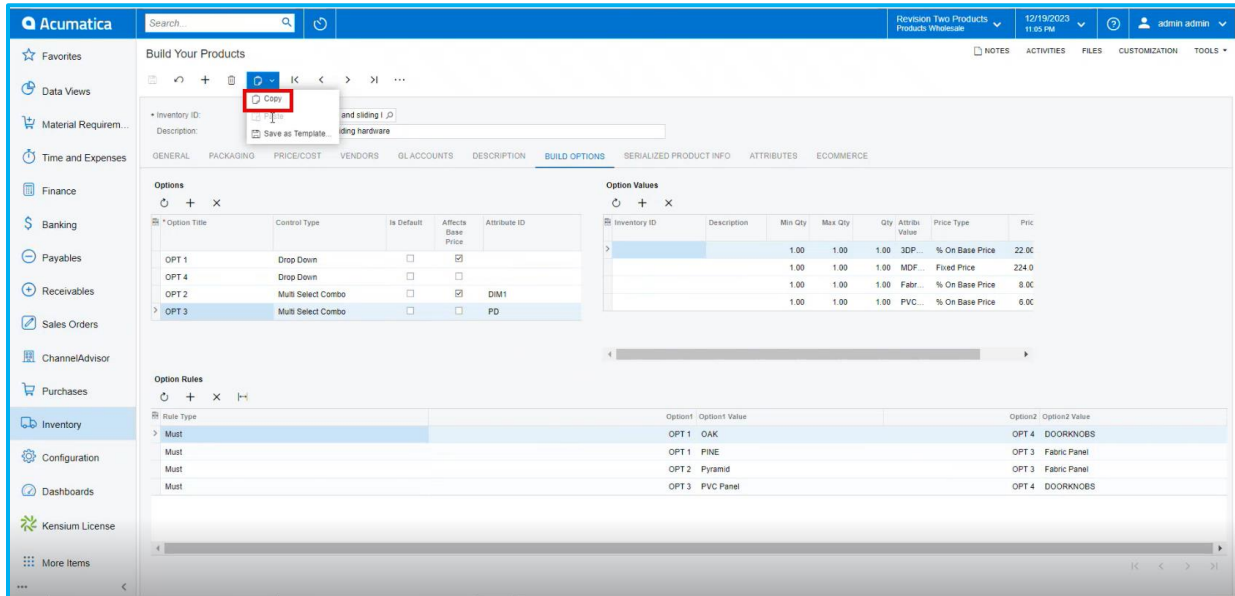


Figure: Build Your Products (Copy)

- Click on **[+]** icon and create a new **[BYP item]** and select **[Paste]** from the options.

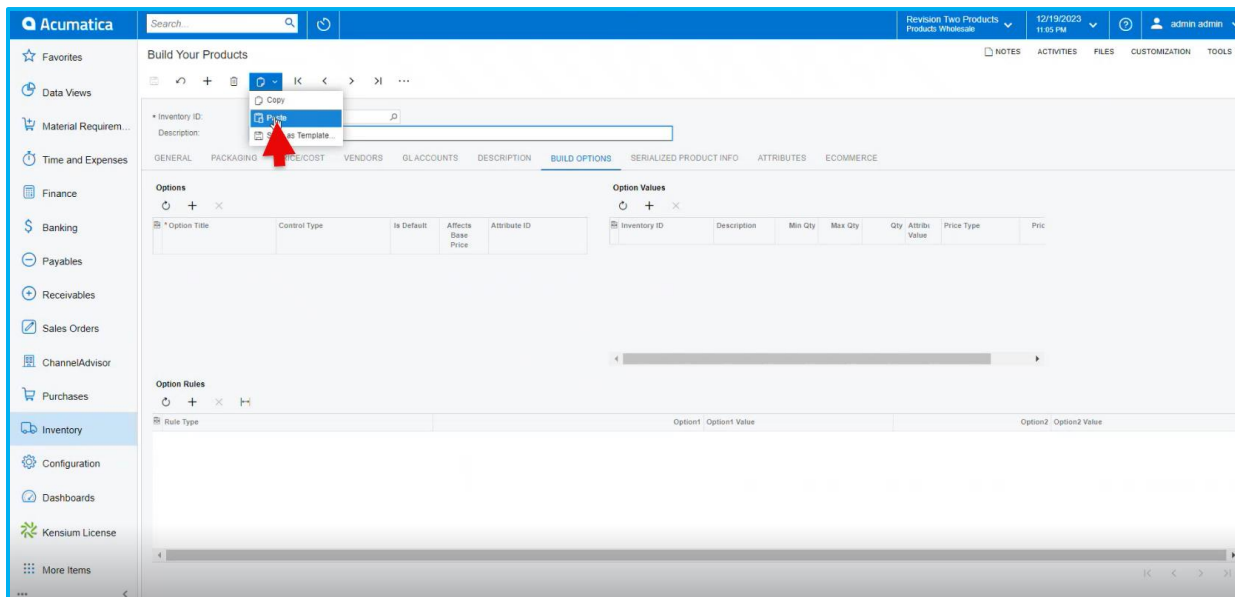


Figure: Build Your Products (Paste)

- Upon selecting paste, the **[Options]** and **[Option Values]** related to the previous item will display.

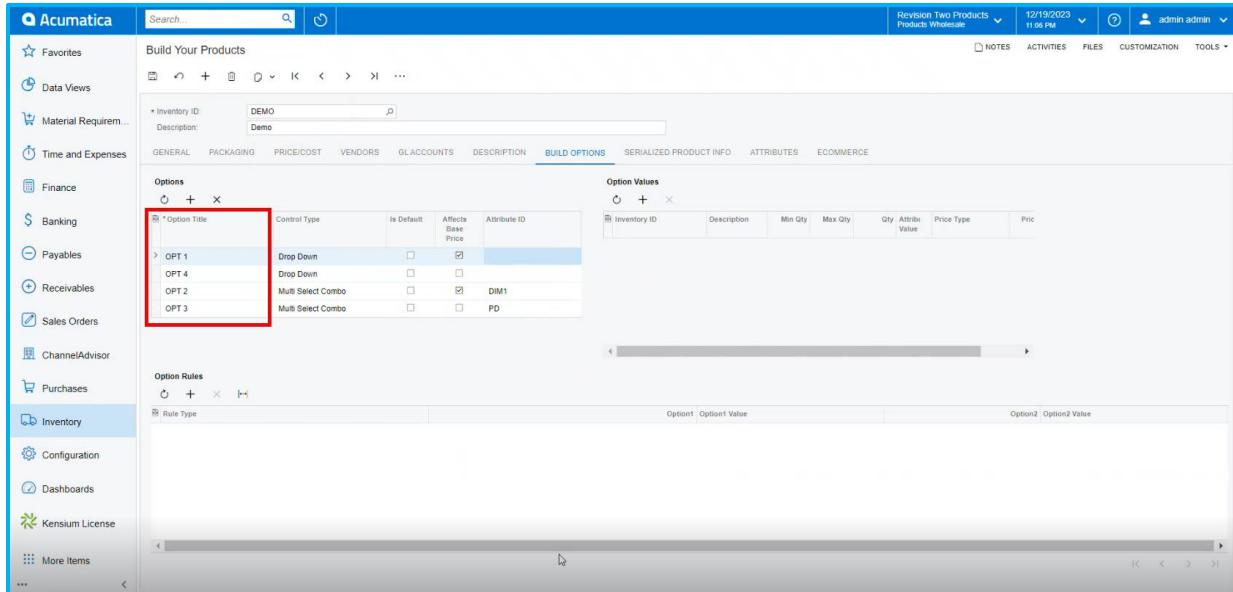


Figure: Build Your Products (Options Title)

Description in Component Grid in SO in config BYP

In the **[Available Options]** section an option called **[Description]** has been included in the Sales Orders Screen.

Navigate to the Sales Order screen and click on **[Configure BYP]**, you can view the updated column under **[Selected items]**.

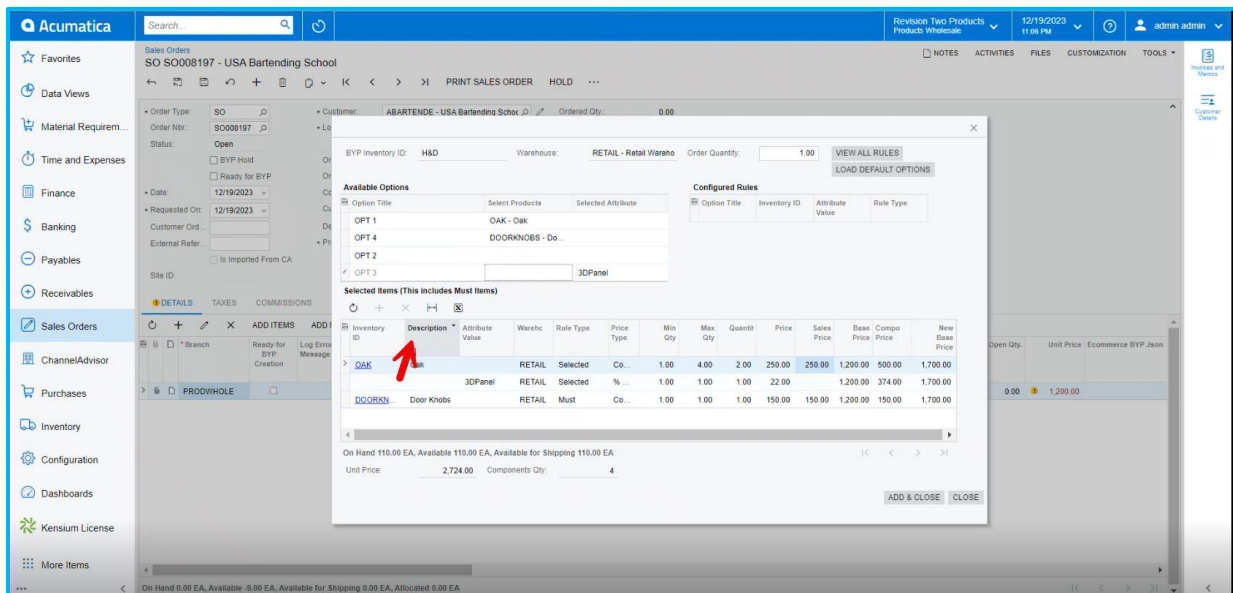


Figure: Sales Orders (Description)

Loading Default Option in BYP

Navigate to the **[Sales Orders]** screen and click on **[Configure BYP]**, you can view the updated option **[LOAD DEFAULT OPITIONS]**.

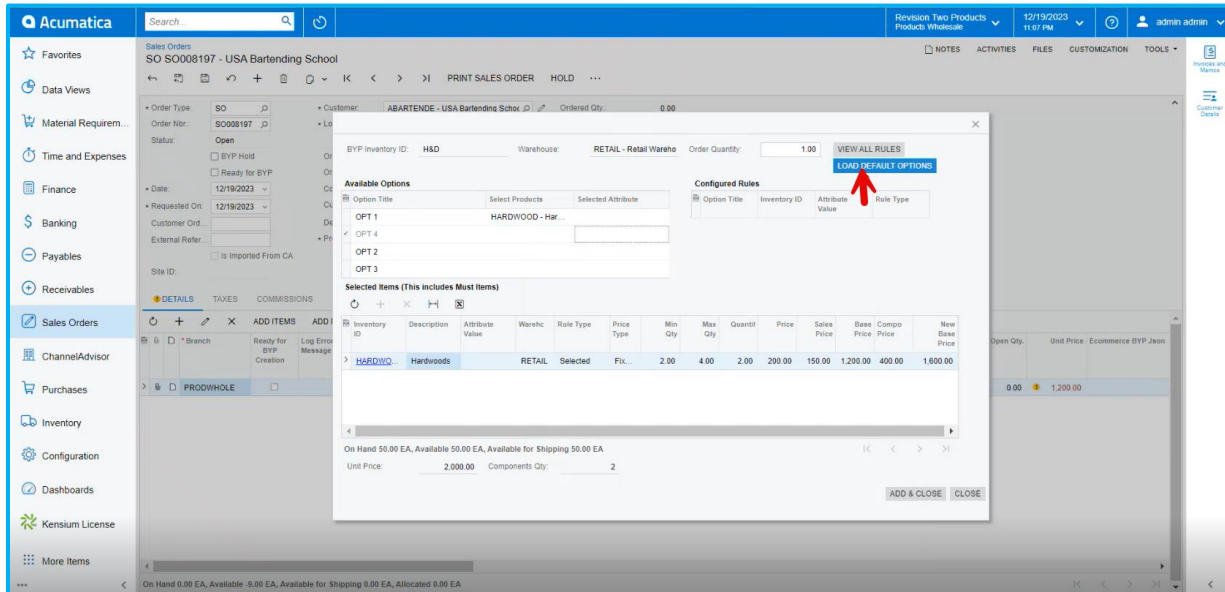


Figure: Sales Orders (Load Default Options)

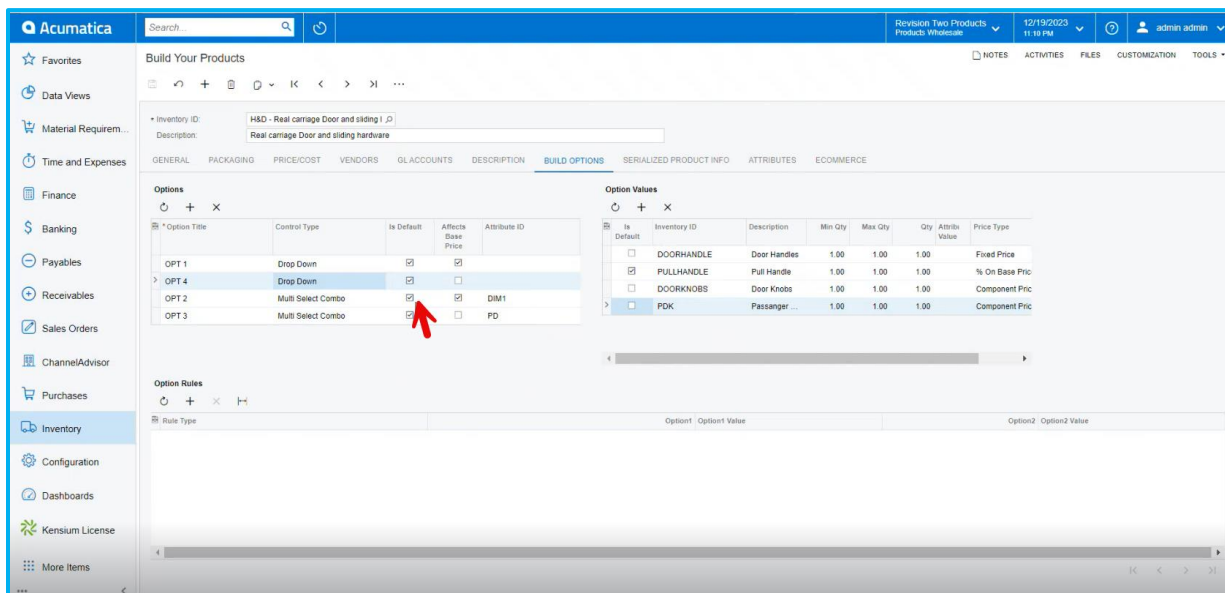


Figure: Build Your Products (Is Default)

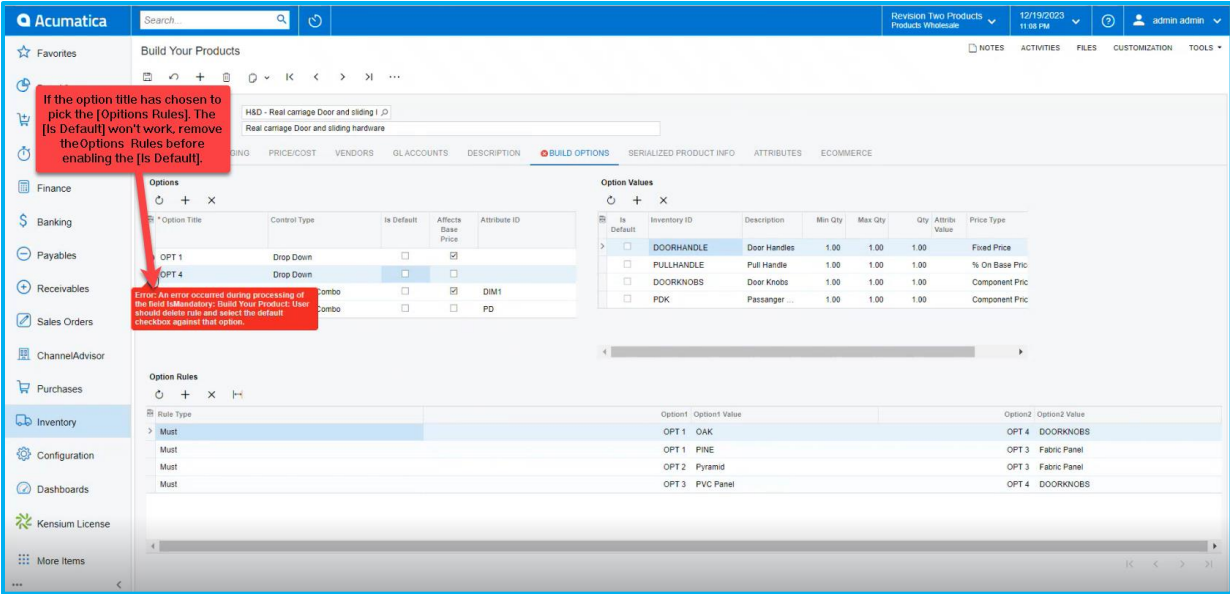


Figure: Build Your Products (Options)

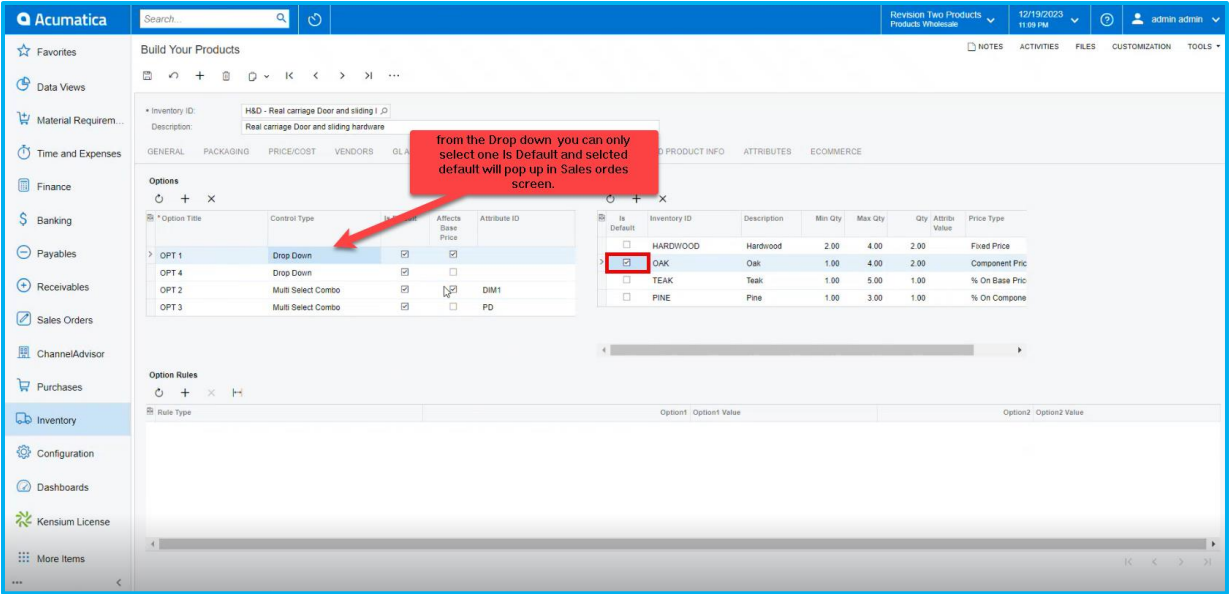


Figure: Build Your Products (Control Type)

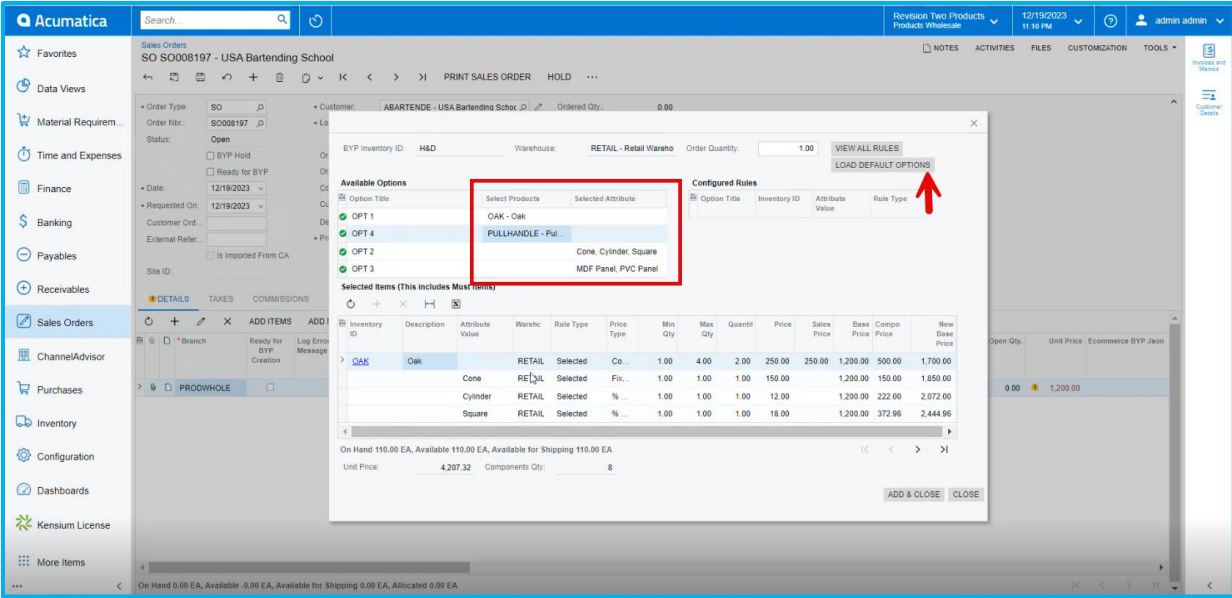


Figure: Sales Orders (Load Default Options)
